**ORDINANCE #2021-3 (BOH)**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 330-20 OF THE BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD CODE SO AS TO REGULATE THE FEES FOR TATTOOING AND BODY PIERCING PARLORS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Health of the Borough of Maywood wishes to update Borough Code so as to provide an annual licensing fee for Tattooing and Body Piercing Parlors that operate within the Borough.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Health of the Borough of Maywood, County of Bergen, as follows:

**Section 1:** Chapter 330-20 (D) is amended to add the following in the schedule of fees for permits and/or licenses:

<b>Description</b>	<b>Fee</b>
Tattooing and Body Piercing Parlors	\$750.00

**Section 2:** All ordinances of the Borough of Maywood which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 3:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance if, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

**Section 4:** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
