ORDINANCE #2-22

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER §21-3 (A) AND (F) GOVERNING THE
BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD'S LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM
(LOSAP) SO AS TO INCREASE THE CONTRIBUTION**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
MAYWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS
FOLLOWS:**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Maywood wish to update Borough Code so as to provide increase the Borough's contribution in the Borough of Maywood's Length of Service Award Program (LOSAP) which was created to reward members of the volunteer fire companies, the fire police and the first aid and emergency squad for their loyal, diligent and devoted services to the residents of Borough of Maywood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Maywood, County of Bergen, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter § 21-3 Contribution calculations and regulations sub section (A) is amended to amend the amount of the annual payment which shall now read as:

- A. The LOSAP shall provide for a annual contribution of \$1800 to a deferred income account for each qualifying active volunteer member who achieves a year of active emergency service in any calendar year under the criteria set forth in this article, beginning with the calendar year starting on January 1 of the year following the adoption of the referendum authorizing the LOSAP, and accumulates the minimum number of points calculated pursuant to the schedule set forth in this article. These contributions shall be made in accordance with a plan that shall be established by the Mayor and Council pursuant to P.L. 1997, c. 388. This plan shall be administered in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, the United States Internal Revenue Code and this article.

Section 2: Chapter §21-3 (F) is amended to amend the amount of the annual payment which shall now read as:

F. The regular annual contribution amount of \$1800 shall increase each year after the first full year at the rate of 5% per year.

Section 3: All ordinances of the Borough of Maywood which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance if, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
