ORDINANCE #2-25

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 169 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD ENTITLED "FEES"**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Maywood revise Chapter 169 of the Borough Code so as to amend Sec 169-1 setting forth Fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Maywood, County of Bergen as follows:

Sec.169-1. Schedule of fees.

K. Street openings, sidewalks and driveways.

(3) Public utility escrow and inspection fees

(a) Public utilities shall reimburse the Borough of Maywood for engineering inspection fees in connection with any street opening permit in the amount of \$1,000 per opening. The rates to be billed against the escrow account will be per the Borough Engineer's schedule of fees. In lieu of such reimbursement, the Borough Engineer may submit invoices directly to the utility and the utility shall reimburse the Borough Engineer directly. The Borough Engineer shall remain in the employ of the Borough regardless of any direct payments by the utility to the Borough Engineer.

(c). The escrow required of public utilities pursuant to Sec. 287-11 of Chapter 287 of the code of the Borough of Maywood is hereby fixed in the sum of \$25,000 per roadway opening. For the purposes of this chapter, a trench length of 100 linear feet would be considered 1 opening (for example, should a utility construct a trench length of 300 linear feet, this project shall be deemed 3 road openings) and/or any opening exceeding 19 square feet within any 200 linear feet of roadway. Any inspection fees not paid within 30 days following billing therefor may be charged against said escrow. In lieu of a cash payment of \$25,000, the public utility may provide a bond in the amount of \$50,000.

All ordinances of the Borough of Maywood which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance if, for any reason, is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
