ORDINANCE #20-22

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER §169-1 GOVERNING THE BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD'S SCHEDULE OF FEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Maywood deem it necessary to update the schedule of fees for the Borough of Maywood.

For the purpose of this ordinance, a trench length of 100 linear feet would be considered one (1) opening. (For example, should a utility construct a trench length of 300 linear feet, this project shall be deemed three (3) road openings) and/or any opening exceeding 19 square feet within any 200 linear feet of roadway. Any inspection fees not paid within 30 days following billing therefor may be charged against said escrow. L. The elevator subcode fees shall be as follows: (1) The fee for a permit to install an elevator device shall be a flat fee.
