2017 RULES AND REGULATIONS

MEMBERSHIP

Membership cards must be presented at the entrance gate to gain admittance to the pool.

Membership cards are not transferable. Pool privileges may be revoked for any infraction.

Children 11 years old and under must be chaperoned during their entire stay at the pool by a pool member at least 15 years old.

Children's memberships are only issued with an adult membership; there are no child only memberships. Child care providers must purchase a single adult membership, and their employer must have a current pool membership.

Lost or illegible membership cards will be replaced at a cost of \$10.00 per card.

Weekly raft night will be posted at the pool. Please check the board.

POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Food and beverages are not permitted outside the snack area. All glass containers are prohibited throughout the pool complex.

In the event of lightening, thunder or other dangerous conditions, the lifeguard is authorized to close the pool at which time everyone is required to leave the pool complex.

The Maywood Pool is not responsible for lost or damaged personal property.

No running at any time.

No animals are allowed in the pool complex.

Baby carriages, playpens and personal belongings are only permitted in the grass areas.

Towels and clothing are not to be hung on the pool fencing or umbrellas.

Personal umbrellas are not permitted in the pool complex; umbrellas cannot be reserved.

Bicycles must be left in the bike racks outside the pool complex.

Cutoffs and other street clothing are not allowed to be worn in the swimming pools.

Do not talk to lifeguards while they are on duty, except in an emergency.

Smoking, alcoholic beverages and gambling are prohibited in the pool complex.

Any person with skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, nasal or ear discharge or open wounds will be refused use of the pool. Exceptions may be made with written notification from a physician.

Rules are posted and must be obeyed.

GUEST POLICY

All guests must be accompanied by a pool member whose family name appears on the guest card. The pool member must remain at the pool with their guests.

Pool members must be at least 15 years old to bring a guest.

Each family membership can purchase a maximum of 2 guest cards per season. Individual and senior citizen memberships can purchase 1 guest card per season.

Guest cards will only be punched once for each pool admission. Unused guest card admittances are valid in future seasons. They are not refundable and do not expire.

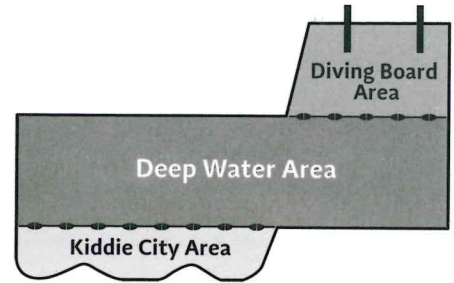
REFUND POLICY—NO REFUNDS AFTER MEMORIAL DAY

YOU MUST SUPERVISE YOUR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES

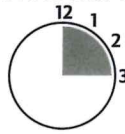
(IF YOUR CHILD IS 6 OR UNDER, YOU MUST SUPERVISE THEM IN THE POOL)

MAIN POOL

- A shower must be taken before entering the pool.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper in both pools.
- Toys, balls, pails, inner tubes, life jackets, masks and fins are not permitted in the Main Pool.
- Children 7-11 years old who have passed the Deep Water Test are allowed in the Deep Water Area of the Main pool unsupervised.
- Children 12 years old and older are allowed in the Main Pool unsupervised.
- To use the diving boards, members 11 years old and younger must pass the Diving Board Test.
- A bracelet will be given to children who pass the water tests. Children must wear their bracelet to be able to swim in the Deep Water and Diving Board Areas. (Lost bracelets can be replaced at the Main Office for \$3.00)



ADULT SWIM

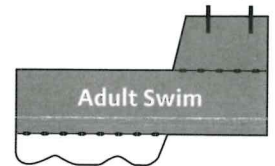


KIDDIE POOL

Begins at the top of the hour and ends quarter after the hour.

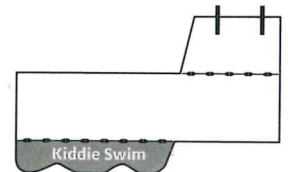
ADULT SWIM

- During Adult Swim only members and guests that are 18 years old and older may swim in the Deep Water/Diving Board Areas of the Main Pool.
- All children 7-17 years of age must leave the Main Pool during Adult Swim.



KIDDIE SWIM

- During Kiddie Swim all children 6 years old and under may swim in the Kiddie City Area of the Main Pool.
- All children must be supervised by a member 18 years old or older. (The supervision must be by a member 18 years old or older because children 7-17 are not permitted in the Main Pool during Adult Swim).



FAMILY



SWIM

Begins quarter after the hour and ends at the top of the hour.

- During family swim, children 6 years old and under may swim in the Kiddie City Area of the Main Pool with supervision by a member that is at least 15 years old.
- If a lifeguard feels there is an unsafe situation, you may be asked to move to the Kiddie Pool.
- Children 6 years old and under who have not passed the Deep Water Test must remain in the Kiddie City Area of the Main Pool (NO EXCEPTIONS).

KIDDIE POOL

- Children 6 years old and under are allowed in the Kiddie Pool; they must be supervised at all times by a member that is 15 years old or older.
- Only small plastic and rubber toys are permitted in the Kiddie Pool.
- Inner tubes, life jackets, masks, fins and large water guns are not permitted in the Kiddie Pool.
