- a) 2021 Maywood Wellness Challenge 8 Week Walking Program

  - 2) Step goal of 15 million
    - (1) 46 residents participated on 4/7/21 walking 207,000 steps
- b) Possibly Amending Ordinance §333-4 Harboring of Certain Animals to Prohibit Roosters
  - 1) There have been a number of noise complaints
  - 2) Chickens are permitted to keep and raise but not to breed or sell
  - 3) Sheep, goats, skunk, mink and fox are prohibited to keep, raise, breed or sell
  - 4) A summary of ordinances for other local municipalities:
    - (1) Rochelle Park does not permit chickens per §73-9.1 Other Animals
    - (2) Paramus permits chickens but requires them to be located no less than 50 feet away from the doors and windows of any dwellings or businesses per §443-58 Minimum Distances from Buildings
    - (3) Hackensack permits chickens but no other fowl in residential areas per §52-6 Certain Animals Prohibited in Residential Areas
    - (4) Fair Lawn has no ordinance regarding chickens, poultry or fowl
    - (5) Saddle Brook has conflicting ordinances:
      - (a) Ordinance §58-29 Keeping of Certain Animals and Reptiles prohibits poultry of any sort or kind
      - (b) Ordinance §157-50 License Required states that a license is required to keep poultry

- (4) Fair Lawn licenses kennels, pet shops, shelters and pounds per §62-3 Kennel, Pet Shop, Shelter or Pound but does not have an ordinance regarding animal hospitals
- (5) Saddle Brook licenses kennels, pet shops, shelters and pounds per §58-9 Kennels and Pet Shops but does not have an ordinance regarding animal hospitals
