

**MAYWOOD PLANNING BOARD
MINUTES
May 28, 2020**

A regular meeting of the Maywood Planning Board was held on Thursday, May 28, 2020 via the “Zoom” online meeting platform at 7:30pm. “This meeting was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act. Notice of this meeting was published in the Our Town and The Record newspapers on or about November 21, 2019. In addition, copies of this notice were posted on the bulletin board in the Maywood Municipal Building at 15 Park Avenue, filed with the Borough Clerk and distributed to all persons, if any, requesting copies of the same pursuant to said act.
