ORDINANCE #2021-1

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD CHAPTER 333-4
HARBORING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Borough of Maywood wishes to amend Chapter 333-4 Harboring of Certain Animals to prohibit roosters to keep, raise, breed or sell.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Borough of Maywood, Bergen County, New Jersey, as follows:

Chapter 333-4 is repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following language. As such, Chapter 333-4 shall read and be numbered as:

§333-4. Harboring of Certain Animals.

- A. No rabbits, hares, guinea pigs or similar animals shall be kept or permitted to be kept in the Borough of Maywood for the purpose of breeding or selling.
- B. No chicken hens shall be kept or permitted to be kept in the Borough of Maywood for the purpose of breeding or selling.
- C. No person shall keep, raise, breed or sell any roosters in the Borough of Maywood.
- D. No person shall keep, raise, breed or sell any sheep or goat in the Borough of Maywood.
- E. No person shall keep, raise, breed or sell any skunk, mink or fox in the Borough of Maywood.

ORDINANCE #2021-2

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD CHAPTER 333-7
ANIMAL SHELTERS AND HOSPITALS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF MAYWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Borough of Maywood wishes to repeal Chapter 333-7 Animal Shelters and Hospitals.

WHEREAS, Chapter 333-7 Animal Shelters and Hospitals reads as:

§333-7. Animal Shelters and Hospitals.

No person shall maintain an animal shelter or animal hospital in the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Borough of Maywood, Bergen County, New Jersey, as follows:

Chapter 333-7 is repealed in its entirety. As such, Chapter 333-7 shall be reserved.
